- CPR and First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain).
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Warm, patient, and engaging approach to working with young children.
- Reliable, punctual, and able to work independently.
- Must pass a background check and adhere to church child protection policies.
- Willingness to work special services (e.g., Christmas, Easter) as needed.
- Ability to lift and move objects up to 50 lbs.

Schedule & Compensation:

- Background checks and Ministry Safe Training will be required of all new hires.
- Primary hours are Sunday mornings from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM, with additional opportunities throughout the week for events, group activities, and special holiday services.
- Compensation will be based on experience and qualifications.
